1. Up-to-date Coggins and shots must be on file with barn.
2. Horses to be wormed with our rotating worming schedule. Full boarders will be charged for wormer every other month. Horses need to be wormed every 6 weeks.
3. Emergency vet care will be provided at our discretion. Vet bills are your responsibility. Our vet Dr. Frank Spelts will be contacted if your vet is not available.
4. Fall and Spring shots are required (F/S)Flu, Rhino (F)Strangles (S)Tetanus/Sleeping Sickness/Rabies, (f/s)WNV. The vet will be here for drawing Coggins and shots all on the same day. This is done in mid March and mid September.
5. **Farrier service is the responsibility of the owner. The horse can be shod on the same day our horses are done. We do not recommend any farriers, that is your choice. Full board horses we will hold your horses for the farrier if on the same day as our horses and you have left your check for the farrier or with the farrier.**
6. 18 years and under must wear barn appropriate shoes and a helmet (when riding) whenever on the horse or grooming the horse.
7. Parents who drop their children off at the barn must pick them up by 6:30 or have made other arrangements with the barn.
8. Any barn member or student at the barn being disrespectful to the barn staff will be asked leave.
9. Horses will be allowed up to 7 lbs. of Endurance Gold 10% a day, or 5 lbs. of Triple Crown senior. Hay will be rationed depending on time of year from 1 to 4 flakes per day or round bales depending on horse and hay availability. **All supplements will be the responsibility of the owner.** We will feed them with their feed but you must purchase them. Horses will be turned out the majority of time as long as the weather is nice. Full Board Horses are brought up due to severe weather, heat, or cold or per owner request(daily or nightly). We will not leave a horse stalled for more than a 10 hour under most circumstances. Boarders that request their horse stay up all but 2 to 3 hours per day are charged at the higher rate.
10. Horses will not be blanketed unless they are full board at \$400 or higher rate.
11. All vet bills and farrier service is to be paid by the owner or lessee of the horse.
12. **Board is due on the 1st and a late fee of \$25/per horse** is added if not received by the 5th of the month. If board is not paid by the 10th then add a \$50/ per horse late fee. A \$30.00 bad check fee will be charged for any returned checks. Money orders or cash to pay board will be required thereafter. Make checks payable to Hunny Pot.
13. **NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED**
14. Dogs must be on a leash
15. Cut lights off when you leave
16. Clean up after your horse and yourself in the wash rack
17. You are allowed any time at the barn to care for your horse. He/she is your property we are just here to provide a clean safe home.

18. We suggest that you provide yourself with a locking tack truck to keep things from being misplaced.
19. In order to keep board low we also ask that you be willing to come for barn day to help clean and do small repairs to the barn. We also ask that you assist in helping clean your stalls when you are here if it has not been done-sometimes we do have an emergency and for some reason the stall has not been cleaned- we are sorry. It does not happen very often but it has happened.
20. Any equipment left out and picked up by the barn staff will be locked in the main tack room and you will required to pay \$2.00 to get your equipment back or perform a chore.
21. Pasture board horses do not have a stall.
22. You must give one month notice to terminate this contract.

I agree to the above boarding rules, regulations, and care of my horse. I understand that I will be called to care for my horse in case of emergency such as colic, severe cut, etc. If you cannot be contacted we will care for your horse until you are able to be here. I agree that emergency vet care can be provided to my horse by
