**Full board \$450/pasture board \$225/partial board \$85 with stall/partial board \$65**

1. Up-to-date Coggins and shots must be on file with barn.
2. Horses to be wormed with our rotating worming schedule. Partial boarders please worm on our schedule. Give me the box with your name on it to prove that you have wormed your horse.
3. Emergency vet care will be provided at our discretion. Vet bills are your responsibility. Our vet Dr. Frank Spelts will be contacted if your vet is not available.
4. Fall and Spring shots are required (F/S)Flu, Rhino (F)Strangles (S)Tetanus/Sleeping Sickness/Rabies, (f/s)WNV
5. **Farrier service is the responsibility of the owner. If we must take over the duty of caring for your horse's feet and pay the farrier we will charge a \$10.00 service fee. You need to leave a check for him. If your horse does not stand for the farrier in the cross ties you need to be here when he is shod unless you are paying for full board.**
6. 18 years and under must wear barn appropriate shoes and a helmet (when riding) whenever on the horse.
7. Parents who drop their children off at the barn must pick them up by 6:30 or have made other arrangements with the barn. Children under 12 may not be just dropped off.
8. Any barn member or student at the barn being disrespectful to the barn staff will be asked leave.
9. Horses will be allowed up to 7 lbs. of sweetfeed a day, or 5 lbs. of equine senior. Hay will be rationed depending on time of year from 1 to 4 flakes per day depending on horse also. **All supplements will be the responsibility of the owner.** We will feed them with their feed but you must purchase them. Partial Board horses this is not a provided service.
10. Horses will be turned out the majority of time as long as the weather is nice. Horses are brought up due to severe weather, heat, or cold or per owner request. We will not leave a horse stalled for more than a 10 hour period.
11. Horses will be blanketed as needed and turn in/out is provided as part of full board or full board and grooming.
12. All vet bills and farrier service is to be paid by the owner or lessee of the horse.
13. Board is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> and a late fee of \$15/horse is added if not received by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month. A 3% daily interest fee will be charged on unpaid amount until day of receipt. A \$30.00 bad check fee will be charged for any returned checks and money orders or cash to pay board will be required thereafter. Make checks payable to Hunny Pot.
14. **1 month notice required prior to removal of horses.**
15. **NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED**
16. Cut lights off when you leave
17. Clean up after your horse and yourself in the wash rack

18. You are allowed any time at the barn to care for your horse. He/she is your property we are just here to provide a clean safe home.
19. We suggest that you provide yourself with a locking tack truck to keep things from being misplaced.
20. In order to keep board low we also ask that you be willing to come for barn day to help clean and do small repairs to the barn. We also ask that you assist in helping clean your stalls daily when you are here if it has not been done-sometimes we do have an emergency and for some reason the stall has not been cleaned- we are sorry.
21. Any equipment left out and picked up by the barn staff will be locked in the main tack room and you will required to pay \$2.00 to get your equipment back or perform a chore.
22. Full Pasture board horses do not have a stall.
- 23. Partial board horses have a paddock with a shelter or a paddock with a stall but you are responsible for everything for your horse. This means mucking stall, shelter, dragging your paddock. Supplying buckets, feed bucket, feed, hay, shavings, etc.**

I agree to the above boarding rules, regulations, and care of my horse. I understand that I will be called to care for my horse in case of emergency such as colic, severe cut, etc. If you cannot be contacted we will care for your horse until you are able to be here. I agree that emergency vet care can be provided to my horse by

**\*No smoking in the barn**

\*Please make sure all stalls and gates are securely latched. Take care that the stalls or latches do not hit the horse when entering or exiting the stall or ring.

\*Horses may be tied only when directed by an instructor. Never tie the horse by his bridle. Remember that a horse cannot see directly behind him, so talk to him when you approach from the rear so he knows you are there.

\*Do not kneel or squat around a horse.

\*When turning a horse loose in stall or in the pasture, lead the horse in and turn him completely around so his head is facing the door or gate and that the gate is shut before removing his halter and letting him loose.

\*Do not let horse sniff noses, they are apt to squeal and misbehave.

\*Helmets are always worn by the rider with harness snapped while around the horse unless there is a medical contraindication.

\*Attire: wear safe and comfortable shoes (NO SANDALS).

\*Dangling, jingling jewelry or keys can upset a horse or be pulled on by the horses.

\* Perfume can attract insects and also some riders maybe allergic.

\*Don't give horses treats without permission from the instructors.

\*Parents do not leave your child at the barn without having made arrangements with the instructors if the child is under 12.

**\* If your horse breaks or your child breaks equipment you are expected to replace it or you will be billed.**

**\* You are responsible for cleaning up poop behind your horse.**

**\* You are responsible for cleaning the tack you use. If Tara has to clean the tack your instructor will be billed and they will charge you \$10.**

**\* Under 18 or taking a lesson you must wear a helmet!!!!!!!!!!!!!!**

\* Every month \$25 will be paid to SWGA Therapeutic Riding Center if you take lessons and use their horses to assist in caring for them unless you are a sponsor.

\* You will be billed for lessons at the beginning of the month.
